What is Hospice?

Hospice is a special kind of care designed to provide sensitivity and support for people in the final stages of a terminal illness and for their families.

Hospice seeks to enable patients to remain alert and pain-free through quality care at home or in a home-like setting.

Pennock hospice care is provided wherever the patient is. This may be in a private residence, assisted living facility, adult foster care, skilled nursing facility, or a hospital.

The focus of hospice care relies on the belief that each of us has the right to die pain-free and with dignity, and that our loved ones will receive the necessary support to allow us to do so.

What is Embracing Hope?

Embracing Hope Bouquets are simple bouquets made from fresh, but not always saleable flowers. Volunteers skilled in floral design assemble the bouquets which are then delivered to the homes of Pennock Hospice patients and bereaved families by Hospice trained volunteers.

The overflow of bouquets are bought to those in local care facilities to brighten their day.
